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# PROOMI STATE OF ROOMMATES & RENTING

In 2017, Roomi grew to over 1 million registered users looking for a room rental or roommate. From East to West, the shared housing marketplace is growing as people look for more flexible housing options that match their lifestyle preferences and needs.

Almost 70% of our users are millennials, and 25% are Gen Z, which makes sense. They're the least likely to be married, or interested in / ready to purchase their own home.

As with previous years, prices in the most trendy neighborhoods continue remain high, so people looking for value are exploring up and coming neighborhoods like Lakeshore in San Francisco and Flatbush in NYC.

Read on to find out which cities are the cleanest, which are the safest, which are the most 420-friendly, and more.







# MILLENNIALS, GEN Z & BOOMERS, OH MY!


### **USER BASE BY GENERATION**



# MOST 420-FRIENDLY AGE GROUPS




### **BACKGROUND CHECKS REQUIRED BY GENERATION**



We found that LA was the cleanest city AND the dirtiest city with 57% saying they clean daily & over 9% saying they rarely clean. Users in Boston & NYC are the least likely to clean daily. This made us think - are they messier or just the most honest?

# PETS - THE "OTHER" ROOMMATE



**LOS ANGELES** is the most pet friendly city. Who else is going to keep you company in all of that traffic?

To make sure we help people match with the best roommates, we ask users to provide us with an idea of their credit score. The numbers between cities varies like crazy.




There ain't no business like show business, but it doesn't seem so great for your credit - people from LA seem to have the credit scores most in need of repair.






If you're looking for affordable in the Bay Area, you need to get out of SF. Thankfully there are other cool cities just a BART ride away like Berkeley and Oakland.









# NEW YORK CITY BY THE NUMBERS








Corona is the most ethnically diverse neighborhood in the world. Move here and you can scratch your travel itch without ever leaving!
